

## An Age Old Mission Mark 7:24-37

## Overview

- Jesus is Savior to all who come
  - God has always wanted a people for Himself (Genesis 1.27-28)
  - o God promises every family will be blessed in Abraham's seed (Gen. 12.3)
  - o God wanted Israel to be a light for the nations (ls. 49)
  - Jesus says to make disciples of all nations (Matt. 28.19-20)
  - Jesus says to Gentile woman that Gospel must first go to Jews
    - Woman agrees she is not deserving of such grace, but pleads nonetheless
    - Also interesting that she understands the parable, most haven't
    - Due to response of woman and her believing and pleading in Christ, He heals
      - This is an indication of the Gospel advancing to the Gentiles
      - This woman came...
        - Humbly
        - Reverently
        - Determined

## · Jesus does all things well

- o People came believing and the man was healed
- This was just it was said of Jesus, the Messiah in Is. 35
  - He would heal blind and deaf
- o This Jesus is the one that speaks and makes all things new
- People see this and are astonished and say of Him, "He does all things well"
  - Just as it was said of God in Gen. 1.31 after creation so son, who is restoring creation does all things well
