Main Idea

How is sinful man to be with a holy God?

Overview

- **What has Christ bought us from?**
 - John 8.34: Enslavement to sin
 - Hebrews 2.14-18
 - Christ delivered us from our enslavement to sin by becoming sin for us
 - 2 Cor. 5.21

- **What has Christ bought us with?**
 - 1 Peter 1.18-19: Bought us with His blood which is more precious than silver or gold
 - Blood was need for, as Scripture teaches, life is in blood
 - Blood of Christ paid our debt that we couldn't pay
 - Because of sinless blood, our sinful blood is paid for
 - This forgives us and frees us from our enslavement to sin

- **What has Christ bought us for?**
 - 1 Peter 1.9-10: Bought to be a people who proclaim the one bought you
 - Not a collection of individuals who did what they want with Freedom
 - Collection of a people (church) who shine the glories of His grace

- **What has Christ bought us to? (Reconciliation)**
 - 1 Peter 3.18: Bought to be brought to God
 - God is our great treasure and our great reward
 - We were created to delight in Him, not in ourselves
 - Our sin enslaves us to ourselves instead of our Great God
 - Christ paid our sin debt that we might delight in Him we were created for
