

Marriage is God's Design

Mark 10:1-12

Main Idea

Marriage is designed and defined by God: Marriage is to be Joined by God, United as one, Bound by Covenant.

Overview

- Posture of Pharisees is accusative
- Asking what can they get away with, not what is most honoring to God
- Jesus tells them that Moses permitted Divorce, but it was not intended to be so from Creation
 - Jesus exposes the sinful hearts of Pharisees
 - Shows how Divorce was never intended, only came b/c of hardness of heart
 - Divorce was a regulation of sin not a license
- · Jesus describes original intent of marriage
 - Goes back to Genesis 1&2
 - o Grounded in Creation
 - o God is one that joined man and woman together
 - o Covenantal language (leave & cleave, one flesh)
 - Covenant is an agreement, often initiated by God (as is case here)
- God uses Marriage to illustrate His love for us
 - o Hosea & Gomer
 - God calls prophet Hosea to marry prostitute Gomer
 - Commands him to love her though she sleeps around w/ on him
 - This was to illustrate God's love towards idolatrous Israel
 - Jesus & Church
 - Jesus loved the equally idolatrous and adulteress Bride, the church
 - We often bow down to other idols and lust after others
 - He still came and bore our sorrows
- Marriage is a high calling that is put together by God, so man should not separate
