

Basic Christianity: Part 2

Colossians 1.5b-8

Main Idea

The Gospel is the word of the truth that comes to us by grace, bears fruit, & grows in others by the Spirit empowered love God gives for our good and His glory.

Overview

I. The Gospel is the Word

- It is a Word that is Heard (vs. 5)
- In order for the Gospel to be believed it must be spoken in words

II. The Gospel is the Truth

- This Truth is a truth From God (vs. 6)
- Not just something to be added to other philosophies; t is THE Truth from God
- It explains the reality of how God has/is dealt/dealing with man & the world
- It is news of the Word of the Truth of what has been done, not what we have to do

III. The Gospel Travels

- Paul says to the Colossians the Gospel has COME TO YOU...indeed it is going into the whole world
- The Gospel was made to move from one person to another that the word might be believed

IV. The Gospel Bears Fruit

• The Gospel is not a message that is still born...it is something that brings forth that which is in keeping with the kind that bore it: It gives life in keeping with the character of God

V. The Gospel Grows

- The Gospel brings about fruit that has us to Grow in number
- The Gospel brings about fruit that has us to Grow deeper into the Gospel
 - o We never move beyond our need for the Gospel: Only deeper into it

VI. The Gospel is the Grace of God

- The Gospel tells us that God has extended grace to guilt ridden sinners
- · Grace: Receiving what you do not deserve
- Grace is not license, but leisure to work from our salvation having been adopted by God

VII. The Gospel has faithful ministers

• Epaphras was a "faithful minister" and so that assumes there are "unfaithful ministers" of the Gospel

VIII. The Gospel causes love in the Spirit

- Love in the Spirit: Church is loving in the power of the Spirit, not the power of the Self
- They are loving because Christ first loved them: So they love others as Christ loved
 - Empowered by the Spirit

- 10. How can we discern "faithful ministers?"
- 11. What does it mean to love in the Spirit?
