Overview

- Why is adultery wrong in the first place?
 - God is Holy:
 - Transcendent/Separate
 - Pure: Has Done no wrong
 - God is Triune: 1 God in 3 Persons
 - Able to Love since He has someone to set His affections upon from all of eternity
 - His Nature, then demands that His love be:
 - Committed
 - Other Focused
 - On One (one God)
 - Of Distinction, not sameness
 - Father loves the Son, not one the same as the Father, etc.
 - For the purposes of Holiness/glory
- Our love has to be the same
 - God is opposed to adultery because it lies about who He is

• B. Adultery

- Marriage is covenantal, not contractual:
 - Contract says: "I take spouse for self, you better do it, III meet you halfway, I have to, it can be broken."
 - Covenant says: "I give myself to my spouse, how can I serve you, III give you 100%, I want to, it can never be broken."
- o Adultery is any sexual activity outside of the covenant of Marriage
 - You give in, you go to a place of death (Proverbs 5.3-5)

• C. Lust

- Lust is not merely temptation, but acting wrongfully on temptation
- Lust is not merely finding something attractive, but acting in a sinful way on that thing
 - When it moves from attraction to arousal is when it goes bad
- Lust is a longing for disobedience:
 - Craving to consume sin
 - Desire to eat what is forbidden (something that is not yours)
- Jesus exposes and condemns not only adultery, but the thing that leads to adultery (lust)
 - No adulterous affair has happened that did not begin with lust
- o God is Sovereign over the internal attitudes as well as the external actions
- The Judgment of this activity is hell
- o Jesus commands maiming if that's what it takes (he speaks figuratively):
 - He speaks in this way to communicate how awful our sin is to God:
 - How serious it is

• D. Plan of Attack

• Understand we are at war...this is spiritual warfare

- Private Devotions: Holistic Prayer that is saturated with God and Bible reading and meditation:
- Meaningful Community involvement in the local church (bear burdens, serve & be served)
- Practical Helps:
 - Note what your triggers are
 - Memorize and Meditate on appropriate scriptures and quote in right times
 - Sing up for Covenant Eyes, X3watch.com, invite someone to look at your history
 - Bounce thoughts/eyes: Push them to things of greater worth
 - ANTHEM: John Piper's acronym
- Grace: Romans 5.20! Be more aware of Gods grace than your sin:
 - Trust God, not your obedience
 - Believe Christ's pleasure is better than sins pleasure
