#### Required Response - To Be Completed AFTER Class

- Take a walk outside (e.g. through a park) and identify at least 10 things that speak to the character of God, which any person could see. List your observations.
- Identify at least 10 things in the person of Christ from the book of Luke about the character of God, which are only revealed in Scripture. List your observations.
- 500-word response (~1 page, single spaced) to each of the three following scenarios.
  - A Christian brother/sister whom you are discipling, asks, "What relevance does the Trinity have for my daily Christian life?" (500 words)
  - A child in Restoration Kids asks, "How is God different than us?" Another child asks, "How are we like God?" (500 words)
  - A co-worker knows you're a Christian and asks you, "How is God's character compatible with suffering and why does this give you hope in the midst of suffering?" (500 words)
