APPLY // PSALM 3

Main Idea: When people are against you, remember the Lord is for you.

- 1. Read Psalm 3. Summarize the main point of this Psalm in a sentence or two.
- 2. How is it both comforting and discouraging to know we'll face troubles as we follow Jesus?
- 3. In times of trouble, why is it so easy to forget Who the Lord is and what the Lord does?
- 4. Consider the various ways Psalm 3 points us to Jesus. How does these truths stir your affections for Christ?
